

- Prepare the draft and final Act 537 Plan using inputs from the KISS municipalities, Arcadis, AECOM, Jacobs, and Kleinfelder
 - Draft plan must be prepared at least 6 months in advance of submission deadline to allow to formal approval process
- Facilitate approval process:
 - · Various stakeholder meetings throughout
 - Track and ensure compliance with strict DEP requirements for the approval process
 - Municipal planning commissions: 60-day comment period
 - Incorporate comments and responses into plan
 - Public comment period: 30 days
 - Incorporate comments and responses into plan
 - Municipal approvals, by Resolution
 - 15 municipalities
 - 2 municipal authorities (LCA & Coplay-Whitehall)
