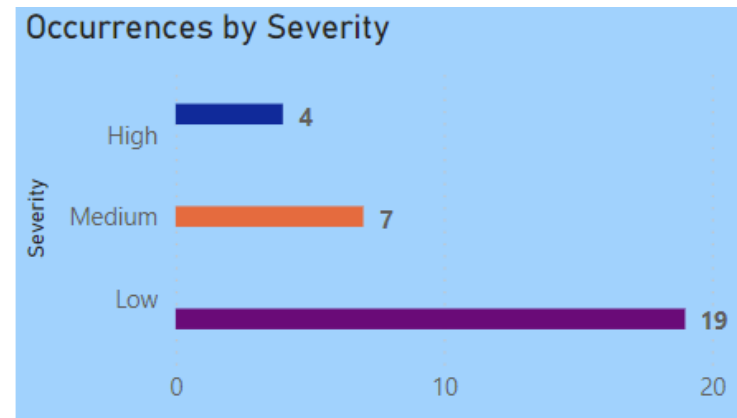
The story so far

- To date we've had 30 recordable occurrences this year, compared to a total of 7 for 2022
 - Plants – 5
 - Customer Care – 1
 - Admin – 4
 - Field Services – 20
- Occurrences over time, company wide
 - Q1 – 6
 - Q2 – 10
 - Q3 – 10
 - Q4 – 4 (as of 11/29)



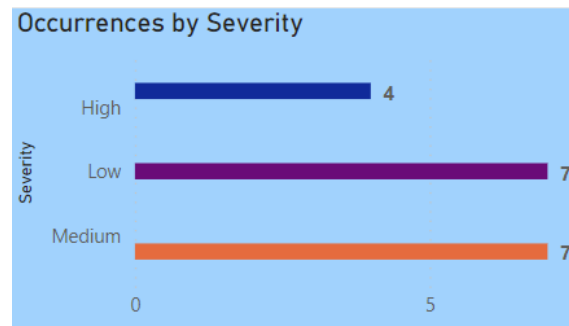
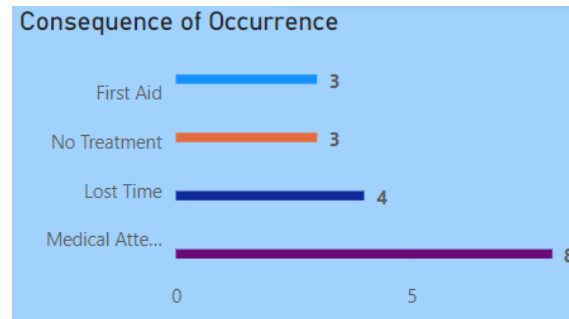
Occurrences by Severity

- Count by High Severity
 - The 4 High Severity items all resulted in lost time
 - 2 shoulder injuries, 1 muscle tear, 1 knee injury
- Count by Medium and Low Severity
 - The remaining 26 incidents include
 - 10 Vehicle Incidents
 - 14 injuries that required minimal medical attention or no treatment
 - 1 Near Miss



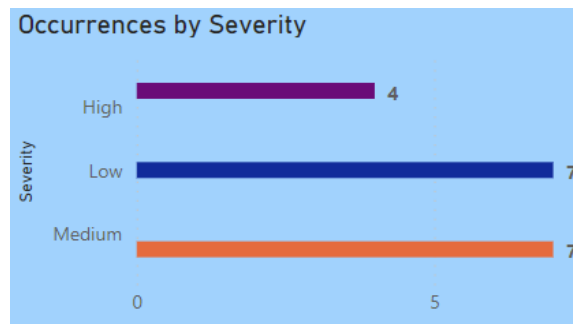
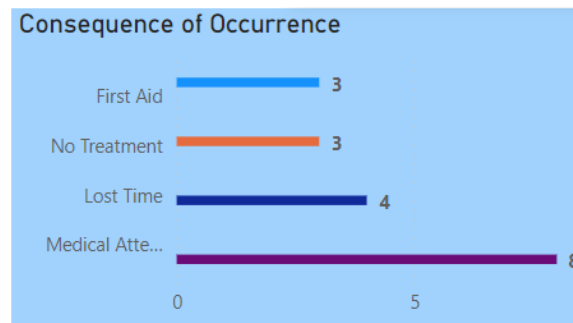
Injury Occurrence Results

- Injury Occurrences – 18 Total
 - First Aid – 3
 - No Treatment Required – 3
 - Lost Time – 4
 - Medical Attention – 8
- Injury Occurrences by Department
 - Plants – 2
 - Admin – 3
 - Field Services - 13



Injury Types

- Injury Types
 - Burn – 1
 - Pinch/Compression – 1
 - Other – 2
 - Puncture/Foreign Object – 2
 - Strain/Pull/Bruise - 12

 - Field Services - 13

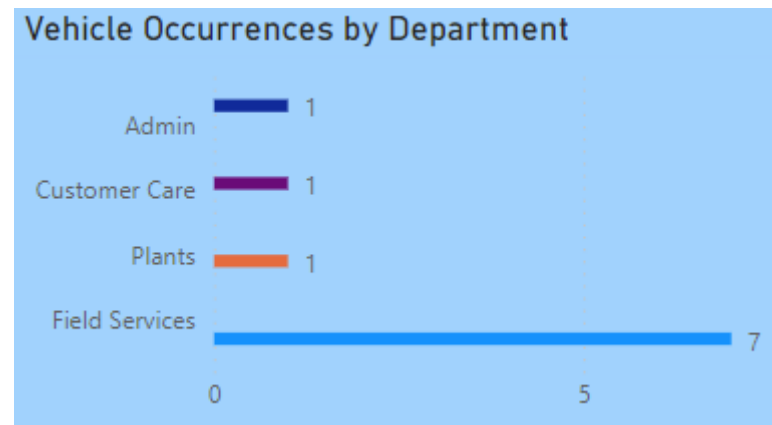


Corrective Actions (examples)

- Bicep Tear
 - An employee stepped out of a mini excavator and slipped off tread.
 - CA – Pivot cab 30 degrees to open wider tread area for step, reinforced 3 points of contact for stepping down
- Back fed grounding
 - Had PPL on site to review emergency procedures
 - Purchased special gloves for testing
 - Purchased special equipment for testing

Vehicle Occurrences

- Total of 10 Vehicle Occurrences
 - Plants – 1
 - Admin – 1
 - Customer Care – 1
 - Field Services - 7
- Injuries for Vehicle Occurrences
 - Plants - 1
