### Drought Watch In Effect: Help Protect Our Water Supply

Lehigh County remains under a Drought Watch due to persistent dry conditions and lack of rain. LCA continuously monitors local water supplies and shares reports on our website. To read the reports online, use the “Your Drinking Water Tab” to find “Water Supply Updates.” View Pennsylvania drought conditions on the state’s website, <https://www.pa.gov/>, using the search words **drought information**.

**During the drought watch, LCA customers' help is needed to protect local water supplies.** Voluntarily reduce your water use by 10-15% by following the tips on our website: <https://www.lehighcountyauthority.org/conserve-water/>.

**Water System Flushing Program:** Our annual system flushing program is underway. Flushing removes sediment that naturally builds up in water lines and helps maintain water quality. Flushing runs from late March through August.

**Brown Water Notice:** Temporary water discoloration may occur due to disturbed sediment. This affects appearance only and does not pose a health risk. If discoloration does not clear up after running cold water for a few minutes, contact LCA.
